

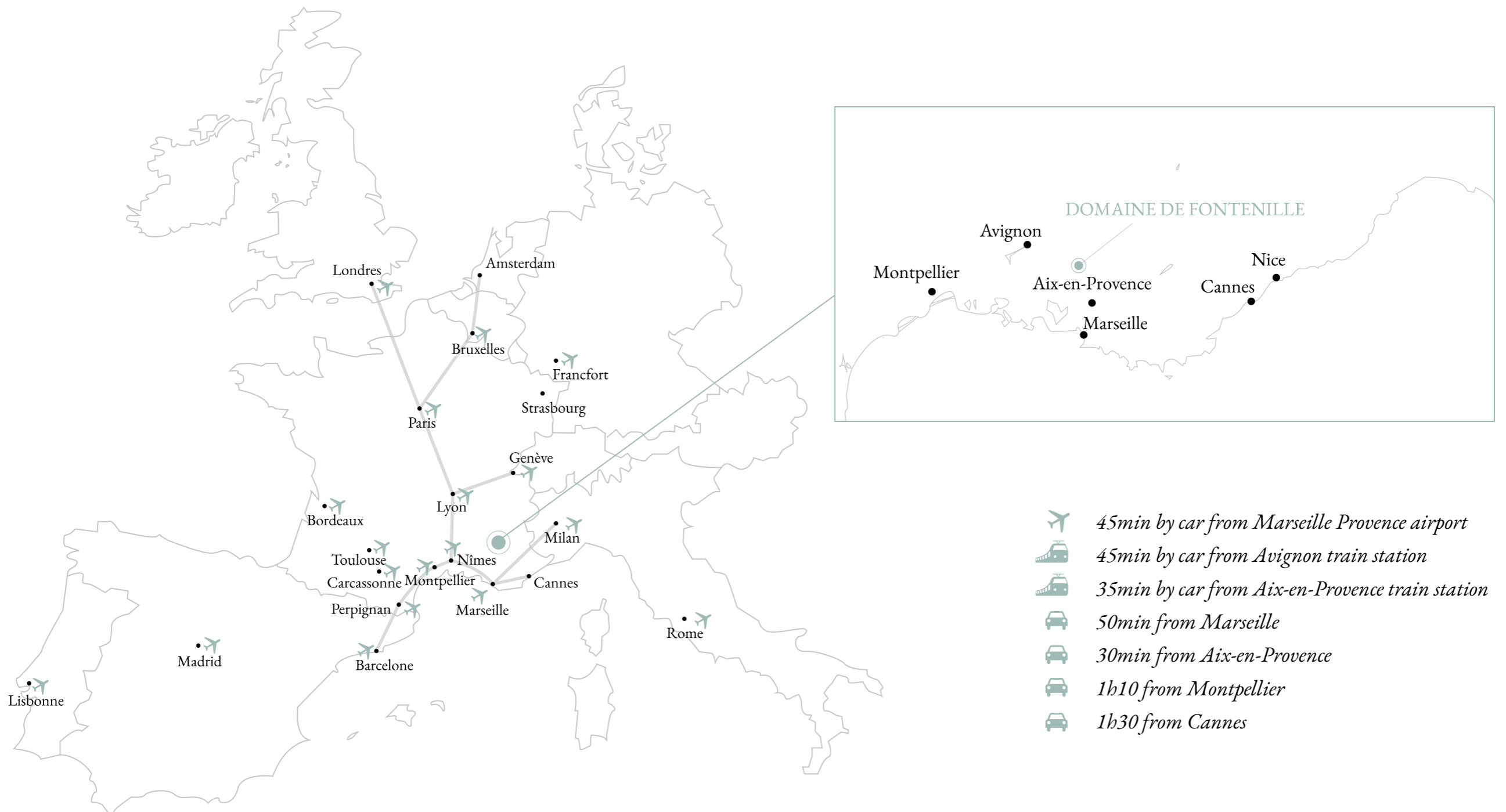

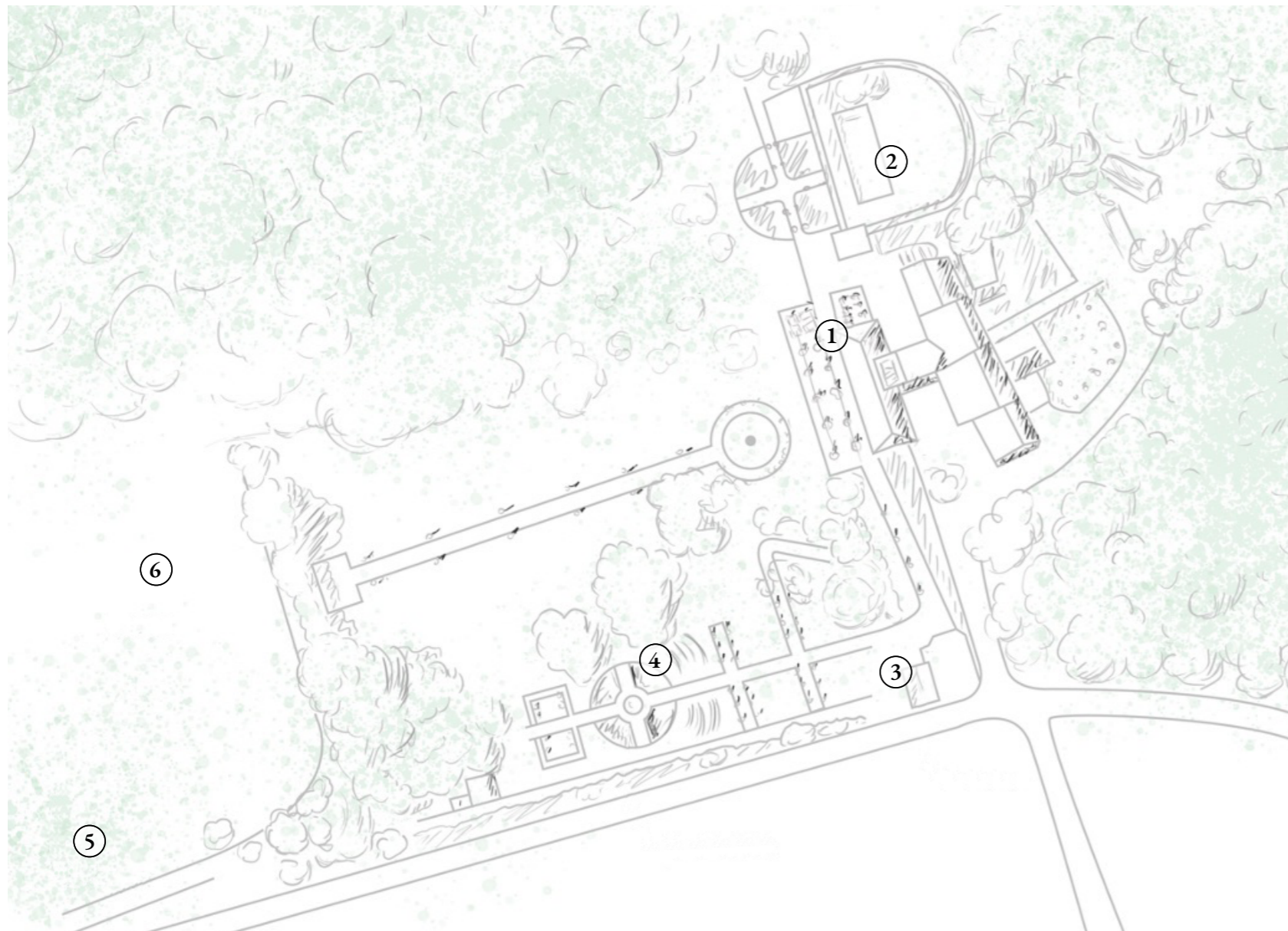

45min away from Marseille Provence airport.

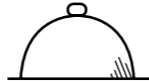


WELLNESS AND RELAXATION
